To show work on calculator problems, show the commands you used, and the resulting matrices. Give exact answers (yes, that means fractions, square roots and exponentials, and not decimals) unless specifically directed to give a decimal answer. This will require some operations to be done by hand even if not specifically directed to. Be sure to complete all parts of each question.

1. A matrix A is 3×3 and det(A) = -2, and another 3×3 matrix B has det(B) = 3. Find each of the following using properties of determinants.

a.
$$det(AB)$$

$$det(-4B^T)$$

$$(-4)^3(3) = -64(3) = -192$$

d. The determinant of the resulting matrix formed from performing the row operation $2R_1 R_2 \rightarrow R_2$ on matrix B.

e.
$$det(B^{-1})$$

2. For the vectors $\vec{u} = \begin{bmatrix} 3 \\ 1 \\ -2 \\ 0 \end{bmatrix}$, $\vec{v} = \begin{bmatrix} -2 \\ 0 \\ 4 \\ 8 \end{bmatrix}$, $\vec{w} = \begin{bmatrix} 1 \\ 1 \\ 2 \\ -7 \end{bmatrix}$, find the following:

a. $2\vec{u} - 3\vec{v}$ $\begin{bmatrix} 6 \\ 2 \\ -4 \\ 0 \end{bmatrix} + \begin{bmatrix} 6 \\ 0 \\ -12 \\ -24 \end{bmatrix} = \begin{bmatrix} 12 \\ 2 \\ -16 \\ -24 \end{bmatrix}$

a.
$$2\vec{u} - 3\vec{v}$$

$$\begin{bmatrix} 6 \\ 2 \\ -4 \\ 0 \end{bmatrix} + \begin{bmatrix} 6 \\ 0 \\ -12 \\ -24 \end{bmatrix} = \begin{bmatrix} 12 \\ 2 \\ -16 \\ -24 \end{bmatrix}$$

b.
$$4\vec{w} + 5\vec{v} - \vec{u}$$

$$\begin{bmatrix} 4 \\ 4 \\ 8 \\ -28 \end{bmatrix} + \begin{bmatrix} 10 \\ 0 \\ 120 \\ 10 \end{bmatrix} + \begin{bmatrix} -3 \\ -1 \\ 2 \\ 0 \end{bmatrix} = \begin{bmatrix} -9 \\ 3 \\ 30 \\ 12 \end{bmatrix}$$
