

Exam 1 Information

- You may take the exam Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, or Saturday. (6/7-6/10).
- You will have 90 minutes to take the exam.
- **DO NOT ARRIVE LATE TO THE TESTING CENTER.** If the Testing Center closes at 8PM, get there by 6:15 at the LATEST. (In general, at least $90+15=105$ minutes before the center closes.)
- **YOU MUST BRING A PHOTO ID TO THE TESTING CENTER.**
- You may bring with you:
 - Pencil,
 - calculator,
 - compass,
 - protractor,
 - ruler,
 - one handwritten (by you!) 3"x5" index card

Everything else, including cellphones, may be held by the Testing Center while you are taking your test.

- To prepare for the test, you should re-read all of your notes (TTK, Discussion Questions, Team Problems, Activities, Homework) and, most importantly, you should work problems from the "Mini-Lessons" posted in the Exam 1 Module on Canvas. You should practice constructions by reviewing the "Bank of Constructions for Exam 1" posted in the Exam 1 Module on Canvas.

There will be an **optional Review Session** on **Wednesday, 6/7 at 6:30-7:30**, in our usual classroom. During this Review session you will have an opportunity to ask whatever questions you have about the Chapters 1-3 material, and we will work through some of the material posted in the Exam 1 Module on Canvas. Please note that if you choose to attend this review you will have to wait until Thursday, Friday or Saturday to take your exam.

- Question types are: vocabulary, multiple choice/fill in the blank, short answer, problem solving, fill-in-the-blank proof, and constructions.
- I expect you to be able to answer questions along the lines of Discussion Questions, Team Problems, Mini-Lesson questions, Praxis Quiz Questions, and SOME Homework Questions or Activities (others may be too involved for a timed test.)
- You will be held responsible for all information contained in TTK packets.
- Do not discuss the exam with your classmates until AFTER the exam period.
- Read and sign the Honor Pledge on the Cover Sheet before turning in your exam.
- If you have an emergency and cannot take the test by Saturday, 6/10, let me know ASAP so that we can plan a make-up test. **DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE TO TAKE THE TEST.**
